f. Maktabas: We are operating more than 50 maktabas across the Birbhum district. These maktabas serve as essential educational centers where children receive foundational Islamic education.

SOCIAL SUPPORT

a. Orphanage: We have contributed to the construction process of at least three orphanages throughout West Bengal.

b. School: We have assisted in the construction of at least five school buildings across West Bengal.





NUTRITION

a. IFTAAR Kits: 50 lakhs: We have spent over Fifty Lakh Rupees towards the distribution of Iftaar kits throughout West Bengal. This investment has facilitated the provision of essential items to support individuals and families in observing the holy month of Ramadan.

b. General Food Distribution: We have spent over two crore rupees on distributing food throughout West Bengal. This significant investment has enabled us to provide essential food supplies to thousands of families in need across the region.

c. Relief Aid Distribution: We have spent over 30 lakh rupees towards distributing relief aid throughout West Bengal. This substantial investment has empowered us to furnish vital food provisions to numerous families facing hardship across the region.

d. Feast Meals for Poor and Orphans: We have spent 20 lakhs rupees towards providing Feast Meals for the poor and orphans. This substantial investment underscores our commitment to addressing hunger and supporting vulnerable populations in West Bengal. With these funds, we have organized elaborate feasts, ensuring that nutritious and delicious meals are served to those in need.





HEALTH CARE SERVICES

a. Blood Donation Camp: We consistently extend our support to blood donation camps organized within our community. e. Blanket Distribution during Winter: During the winter season, we undertook a heartfelt initiative to distribute 2000 blankets to those in need within our community.
